

2021 GRI DESIGNATION REQUIREMENTS

The GRI Designation is divided into 4 categories
(All classes also qualify for MN CE):

- I. Sales Process
- II. Legal & Regulatory
- III. Technology
- IV. Professional Standards

Our currently approved GRI Accreditation program includes 15 required courses, PLUS an additional 15 hours of elective courses to be completed within a five year time period.

One (1) course from all 15 rows is required.
